- The harbor is open for visiting boats from Monday noon (21.8) to Monday noon (28.8). Should you need berthing outside these dates please let us know.
- Exact location of berths at HSK during the race week will be disclosed later
- All boats should be at HSK and in the water by 4 PM on Wednesday (23.8), preferably already on Tuesday at 3PM. No lifting of boats or diving with equipment should be done after this time.

Boat and crew compliance

- The main compliance principle is the self-declaration that can be found in the class rules
- Any known exceptions on your boat to the class rules should be communicated to the Executive Committee at your earliest convenience for approval. A list of approved exceptions (like carbon wheels on selected boats) will be made public to everyone
- Boats will be inspected to carry the safety gear listed in Appendix C of the Class Rules
- Sails might be measured by the organizers, but no exhaustive measurement will be conducted
- Crew members will be weighed during registrations

Registration

- For registrations, please bring with you the following documents.
 - 1. Sail inventory list (template in the class rules document)
 - 2. Crew list and compliance declaration (template in the class rules document)
 - 3. Copy of insurance certificate: "Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 250 000 eur per incident for material and 500 000 eur for personal injuries or the equivalent."
- All crew members should visit the registrations office for weighins
- Collect your bow numbers during registration and attach them to the boat before racing
- Owners and crew might be required to sign a waiver of liability prior to racing



Beware shallow waters

- The coastline of Finland is relatively shallow and rocky
- Take care and have someone continuously navigating when sailing or motoring outside the race area
- The race area is all safe, but *close to* the area there are selected shallow spots that you should take note of and avoid when entering/leaving the race area
